


# The Career Services Department Needs YOU!

**Spotlight on the Cheer and Charrelles Teams** 



The IHSA recently gave the green light for *some* winter sports to resume and compete! Two Conant teams eagerly prepping for competition later this month are the Charrelles and Co-ed Cheer! However, competition season looks a lot different this year.

"This year competitive cheerleading cannot have contact, which means no stunts, coed skills, baskets, or pyramids, and athletes must be 6ft apart, and cannot share props during the routine. We definitely have to be more creative with this new format and think outside the box. Additionally, all invites are virtual and only our MSL Conference competition will be held in person," reports Cheer Varsity coach Amanda Schweinebraten.

The Charrelles have similar COVID-19 requirements for their dance routine. Coach Jennifer Crassweller says other huge differences this year were significant, not only for skills but also emotional connections.

"One of the biggest differences in the 2021 CHS Charrelles competition season compared to seasons past is the lack of team technique classes & team bonding activities. We've always felt that these things are the most important to the Charrelles program & help us be a strong, united, elite team."

Both teams will also be submitting video recordings for most of their competitions rather than being able to perform live. The mask requirement also eliminates facial expressions as part of either of their routines. The cheer team is also not allowed to *cheer*.

"Our biggest challenge is showing off our team's passion, energy, and endurance through a video format versus being live. Athletes cannot show off presence or expressions with masks, so we have to work even harder to show off our skills while making it look effortless and larger than life on video," says Schweinebraten.

Both teams' coaches are extremely happy their sports get a state series, when most other winter sports will not. They're especially happy the eight seniors on each team will have this final opportunity to compete in a high school sport they love. Both coaches say their athletes have endured and pushed through these unprecedented times with a strong work ethic.

"I'm inspired by our dancers every day! Their positive attitudes, willingness to participate & dedication is amazing," exclaims Crassweller!

With competition right around the corner, these teams are ready to not only perform, but shine!

"Conant Cheerleading has qualified for the IHSA State Series for 15 consecutive years (every year competitive cheerleading has been an IHSA sport) and we are hoping to add a 16th year to the 2021 season," declares Schweinebraten.

Good luck to both teams at the JV and Varsity levels! Go Cougars!
