Conant is reaching out to our families and asking you to participate in the annual Illinois 5Essentials Survey. Your perspectives can help guide our school's improvement efforts. The survey assesses perceptions of five components of school success:

- Ambitious instruction

The parent survey will be available online in English and Spanish from January 24, 2023 through March 31, 2023, here. It takes about 10 minutes to complete. Note that the survey will time out and you will need to start over if you don't finish in one sitting.

The survey is administered by UChicago Impact at the University of Chicago on behalf of the Illinois State Board of Education. If at least 20 percent of parents at our school complete the survey, a supplemental parent report will be generated and shared with us.


Now taking nominations for 2023-24 Conant Boosters Officers
