Started field meetings again. They are ready to get out there. Will sod varsity soon. Anticipate fall teams will not be on there. Summer camp dates updated. We are hosting sections. He will discuss additional concessions with committee heads.

**President –** Elizabeth Paveza was present and reported we have updated our fonts and continue to focus on consistency with branding. Last meeting, we created a nominating committee. This meeting they were approved unanimously. Last meeting, we discussed adjusting staff membership to \$10. Took a vote and was approved unanimously. Presented idea of having a staff breakfast at the beginning of next school year to tie in with facilitating membership. All approved idea. Goal is to set the date for Friday, August 9. All committees, except scholarship, have chairs or co-chairs. We are in good shape with planning for next year.

**Conant Social Fundraiser -** Traci Garcia and Dynette Lucas were present and reported Casino theme was a hit. Financials show a profit of \$5488.30. Paid \$2825 to casino company. Positive feedback regarding company. PayPal fees \$340. We need to look into the percent of fees since we are a not for profit. We paid 3%, could be 1.75%. Worked out to \$39.77 profit per person. 138 people were in attendance. Discussed possibility of having Casino Night again next year and pondered the question: How can we get the word out? Possibly pass out flyer with membership at beginning of year and passing out flyers as early as football games in fall.

**Concessions -** Dan Sarich was not present. Submitted report that Spring volleyball concessions starts next week. They are looking for volunteers. Paula will post.

**Craft Fair -** Tracy Gebhardt was not present. It was reported 118 booths are already booked for next year. The date for the craft fair next year is Saturday, September 28.

**Dances -** Kathy Stanislawski was not present. RoseAnne Caboor was present and expressed concern regarding the possible plastic bag tax. If it goes through, we would need to budget for plastic bags or get them sooner.

**Fundraisers -** Jenn Reiger and Carol Hominac were present. Jenn reported the total raised for the mattress fundraiser came in at \$2365.00. Every person who came through the door bought a mattress. We didn't get the word out like we could have. Pushing 2 events at once hurt us. Need to pick the date early and go to school events to promote. It makes a big difference. After 25 mattresses, we get more money. Fundraising committee raised a total of \$4700 this year. Need to determine how to space out our fundraising for next year.
