- Ten \$1000 Conant Cougar Booster Club Scholarships

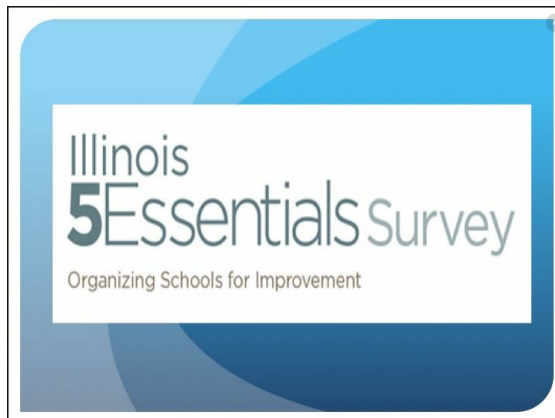
The two applications with the highest scores will receive the \$1,500 scholarships, while the ten applications with the next highest scores will receive \$1000 scholarships.

There's still time to fill out the District 211 5Essentials Survey!

The 5Essentials Survey is a statewide effort by the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) to gauge school climate and learning conditions in Illinois schools.

The survey is administered online by UChicago Impact through the University of Chicago and provides a unique opportunity for parents/guardians/caregivers, students, and teachers to have a voice. This survey is designed to generate a detailed picture of the inner workings of your child's school.

As a parent, this opportunity will allow you to share your thoughts on the important elements of school effectiveness. The survey gathers data related to five indicators that can predict important student outcomes, including improved attendance and larger test score gains. These indicators that

affect and predict school success are:

- Effective Leaders
- Collaborative Teachers
- Involved Families
- Supportive Environments
- Ambitious Instruction

Your participation will help Conant High School leadership drive improvement efforts. Your identity and survey responses will be kept completely confidential and will never be connected to you or your child.
