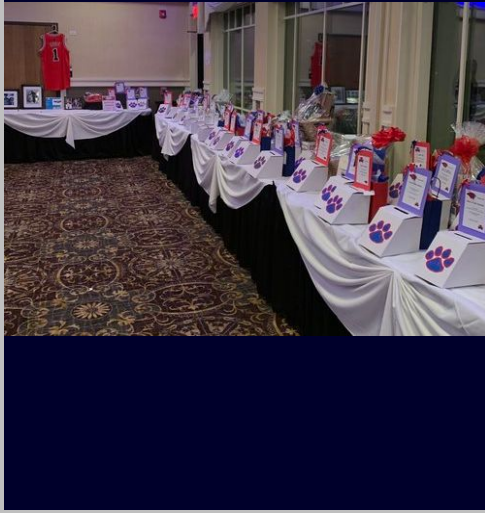


Spotlight on Conant Girls Wrestling

The 2019-2020 school year is seeing the inaugural ALL GIRLS wrestling team at Conant High School! And according to Coach Chad Hay, it could be the first such team in the state!

Two years ago there was one girl on the boys team, last year it grew to 5 and now the girls-only team has 15!

"I began to think about how to build girl wrestling numbers, and the thing that holds girls back from wrestling is that they have to wrestle the boys. I thought that if I started a girls wrestling team where the girls wrestled other girls instead of wrestling boys, that they would gain everything that the sport has to offer without having to compete in physical combat against the boys," says coach Hay.



Before Thanksgiving the girls won their first girls v girls competition. In December, Conant hosted an all girls tournament and more than 60 young women attended!

Coach Hay thinks the Conant team will double in size next year and girls wrestling will become an IHSA sport within 5 years.
