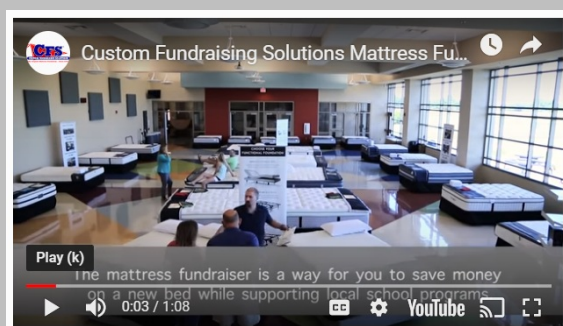
out to Casino Night! Tons of fun was had by all! Thanks to your support, this event was wildly successful.
